STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED
FORTY-ONE

AN ACT to Prohibit Certain Political Activities.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows :

Sec. 1. Certain political activities by state employees restricted. No state employee other than an elected official shall hold office in any organization of a political party, nor shall he solicit contributions from any person, firm or corporation to the campaign fund of any political party or political candidate. Nor shall any person solicit funds directly or indirectly for the furtherance of any political campaign from any employee of the state.

Sec. 2. Penalty. Whoever violates any provision of this act shall be punished by a fine of not more than \$500.
