STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-ONE

AN ACT to Authorize Mining Activities under Hid Pond in Franklin County.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Mining in Hid pond; authorized. Everett Greenleaf, Eugene E. Frederick, and Harold L. Nichols, all of the town of Starks, are hereby authorized to, and granted the right to, mine and excavate for feldspar and kaolin within the borders of Hid pond in Franklin county, and to hold as their own property, or to sell such feldspar and kaolin as they obtain therein.
