STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-ONE

AN ACT Relating to Taxing Entertainment Halls, Requiring Paid Admissions.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Certain buildings to be taxed. All dance pavilions, halls and other buildings, in which, rental or paid admissions are required for entertainments held, shall be taxed.
