**RESOLVE, Regulating Fishing on Echo Lake.**

---

**Fishing on Echo lake, regulated. Resolved:** That the commissioner of inland fisheries and game be, and hereby is, directed to issue a rule and regulation prohibiting any person from taking more than 2 togue in 1 day and any group of persons that use the same boat at the same time from taking more than 3 togue in the aggregate during the day they used the same boat on Crotched pond or Echo lake, so-called, in Kennebec county.
