STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-ONE

AN ACT Relating to Lobster Fishing Licenses.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

- P. L., 1933, c. 2, § 73, amended. Section 73 of chapter 2 of the public laws of 1933, as amended, is hereby further amended by adding at the end of the second sentence thereof the following sentence:
- 'A fisherman's license shall be valid only for the use of the person to which it was issued, and shall not permit the servant, agent, or employee of the licensee to catch or take lobsters.'
