### STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-ONE

AN ACT Relative to Recording Meters on Fuel Oil Trucks.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

- Sec. 1. Trucks delivering fuel oil to have recording meters. All trucks used for delivering fuel oil shall be equipped with a recording meter. The said meter shall be of such a type that will record the number of gallons of fuel oil delivered to the customer on the statement to be given to the customer, so that the statement, of the number of gallons of fuel oil delivered to the customer, which shall be given to the customer at the time delivery is made, will show the exact number of gallons delivered.
- **Sec. 2. Penalty.** Any person, firm or corporation that shall operate or cause to be operated a truck for the purpose of delivering fuel oil without the same being equipped as provided in section 1 hereof, or who shall violate any other provision of this act shall be punished by a fine of not more than \$50.
