RESOLVE, Granting Bonus to Charles Story Crosman, of West Gardiner.

Charles Story Crosman granted state bonus. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated, \$100 to be paid to Charles Story Crosman, of West Gardiner, as his World War bonus; said sum to be paid from the general state funds.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

Every honorably discharged veteran was voted a state bonus of \$100 if application was made by a certain date. Mr. Crosman failed to make his application before the specified date. He enlisted in the United States Navy December 14, 1917, at Portland, Maine, and was honorably discharged on February 3, 1919, at Brooklyn, New York.
