RESOLVE, in Favor of Howard Douglass, of Upton.

Howard Douglass; compensated. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated the sum of \$123.65 to be paid to Howard Douglass, of Upton, to compensate Mr. Douglass for damage to his car by a deer; said sum to be paid from the appropriation for the department of inland fisheries and game.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

The bill for expenses incurred in this accident was not approved by the department because of the fact that Mr. Douglass was involved in a similar accident the previous year. A witness to the accident believes it was unavoidable, and that Mr. Douglass tried to the best of his ability to avoid hitting the deer.
