RESOLVE, Regulating Fishing in Damariscotta Lake.

Fishing in Damariscotta lake, regulated. Resolved: That the commissioner of inland fisheries and game be, and hereby is, directed to issue a rule and regulation establishing a daily limit of 5 bass per person per day, not to exceed 10 pounds, on Damariscotta lake, county of Lincoln.
