**RESOLVE, Regulating Fishing in Round Pond.**

---

**Fishing in Round Pond, regulated. Resolved:** That the commissioner of inland fisheries and game be, and hereby is, directed to issue a rule and regulation opening Round Pond in Charlotte, county of Washington, to ice fishing for pickerel, white perch, hornpout, yellow perch, eels, cusk, chubs and smelts from the time the ice forms in the fall until it goes out in the spring and for all fish (except bass) during February, March and April, and prohibiting the sale of pickerel taken therefrom; and establishing a daily bag limit of 10 fish per person per day during the legal open season.
