RESOLVE, in Favor of Mrs. Albertha Williams, of Bath.

Mrs. Albertha Williams; compensated. Resolved: That there be, and is, appropriated the sum of \$300 to be paid to Mrs. Albertha Williams, of Bath, as a full and final settlement of all claims against the state for damage to her land and house occasioned by the raising the grade of the road; said sum to be paid from the general highway funds.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

Reconstruction of the highway immediately in front of the house owned by Mrs. Williams, located at 92 High Street, in Bath, caused damage to the cellar wall and water to flow through the wall and cellar. Other damage was occasioned because of the settling of the house.
