STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-ONE

RESOLVE, in Favor of Mrs. Estella M. Littlefield, of Hampden.

Mrs. Estella M. Littlefield; compensated. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated, the sum of \$400 to be paid to Mrs. Estella M. Littlefield, of Hampden, as a full and final settlement of all claims against the state for damage done to her property by the natural course of a stream being changed by the building of a diversion dam in the process of building a fishway, on Sourdabscook Stream; said sum to be paid from the funds of the inland fisheries and game department.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

The state built this fishway in 1935, and by changing the natural course of the stream, the water has worn away about an acre of land which would have been suitable for 3 cottage lots.
