RESOLVE, Granting a Pension to Eva Mae McShea.

Eva Mae McShea, pension for. Resolved: That a pension be, and hereby is, granted to Eva Mae McShea of Fort Fairfield to be paid quarterly from the appropriation for teachers' pensions. Said pension shall begin 90 days after the adjournment of the legislature and shall continue until otherwise provided by the legislature.
