STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-ONE

AN ACT Making Unlawful the Deposit of Certain Materials in or on the Banks of the St. John and Fish Rivers.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 38, § 36, amended. The 3rd paragraph of section 36 of chapter 38 of the revised statutes, as revised, is hereby amended to read as follows:

'The following rivers and their branches are exempted from the provisions of the preceding paragraphs: Salmon Falls river, Mousam river, Saco river, Presumpscot river, Androscoggin river, Kennebec river, Penobscot river, St. Croix river, St. John river **excepting all its tributaries**, and Fish river. Whoever violates any provision of this section shall pay a fine of not less than \$5 nor more than \$100 and costs for each offense.'
