RESOLVE, in Favor of a Pension for Lena Butler Richards.

Lena B. Richards; pension for. Resolved: That a pension be, and hereby is, granted to Lena Butler Richards of St. Albans, to be paid quarterly from appropriation for teachers' pensions. Said pension shall begin 90 days after adjournment of the legislature and shall continue until otherwise provided by the legislature.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

Lena Butler Richards has taught 30 years, and the required number of years in Maine. She has taught but 7 of the last 15 years of service required to have been within the state preceding retirement as specified in section 219, chapter 19 of the revised statutes which would make her eligible for a pension of \$375 annually.
