AN ACT Relative to Training of Fox, Coon or Rabbit Hounds.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 38, § 72, additional. Section 72 of chapter 38 of the revised statutes, as revised, is hereby amended by adding thereto at the end thereof a new paragraph to read as follows:

‘(k) **Fox, coon or rabbit hounds may be trained on foxes, coons, and rabbits from September 1st to October 15th, if under the personal supervision of the owner at all times.**’
