STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED
FORTY-ONE

RESOLVE, in Favor of Blanche G. Cobb, of Lisbon.

Blanche G. Cobb; state pension. Resolved: That a pension be, and hereby is, granted to Blanche G. Cobb, of Lisbon, to be paid quarterly from the appropriation for teachers' pensions. Said pension shall begin 90 days after the adjournment of the legislature, and shall continue until otherwise provided by the legislature.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

Miss Cobb has taught for 35 years, more than 20 years of which have been in the state of Maine. Immediately preceding retirement, she lacks approximately $2\frac{1}{2}$ years of meeting the provision of the law which calls for 15 years of service in Maine preceding retirement. As Miss Cobb has spent the greater part of her teaching service in this state, it is recommended that a state pension be granted to her.
