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**RESOLVE, in Favor of Ella M. Jude, of Ellsworth.**

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**Ella M. Jude; state pension. Resolved:** That a pension be, and hereby is, granted to Ella M. Jude, of Ellsworth, to be paid quarterly from the appropriation for teachers' pensions. Said pension shall begin 90 days after the adjournment of the legislature, and shall continue until otherwise provided by the legislature.

## STATEMENT OF FACTS

Miss Jude has taught in Maine,  $26 \frac{2}{3}$  years, and out of the state, 6 years, making a total of  $32 \frac{2}{3}$  years. Immediately preceding retirement, she taught in Maine 5 years instead of 15 years as prescribed by law to receive a pension. As Miss Jude has spent the greater part of her teaching service in this state, it is recommended that a state pension be granted to her.
