RESOLVE, Authorizing the Improvement of Fort Knox Reservation.

Improvement of Fort Knox Reservation authorized. Resolved: That the forest commissioner is hereby authorized and directed to sell so much of the timber from the Fort Knox Reservation in the town of Prospect as will not detract from the beauty of the scenery.

The timber shall be sold to the highest bidder under such regulations as the commissioner shall issue, provided however, that the commissioner may reject all bids that do not offer a reasonable market price for such timber.

The proceeds from such sale shall be expended under the direction of such commissioner in building a suitable road on the reservation property from the state highway to the granite wharves on the reservation on the Penobscot river; and in building fireplaces, tables and shelters, and providing other facilities for picnic parties and the general public on the reservation, and in restoring the various parts of the fort to as good condition as possible with the funds available.
