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**RESOLVE, to Repeal a Resolve Providing for a State Pension for Lot Edmund Whitman.**

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**Resolves, 1931, c. 98, repealed in part. Resolved:** That that part of chapter 98 of the resolves of 1931 which provides for a state pension for Lot Edmund Whitman, be, and hereby is, repealed, to become effective July 1, 1941.

### STATEMENT OF FACTS

Lot Edmund Whitman of Jay was granted a state pension of \$20 per month under the provisions of chapter 98 of the resolves of 1931. Mr. Whitman has been living in Massachusetts for more than 5 years and is receiving old age assistance from that state.
