RESOLVE, to Repeal a Resolve Providing for a State Pension for Mary Kane.

Resolves, 1939, c. 77, repealed in part. Resolved: That that part of chapter 77 of the resolves of 1939 which provides for a state pension for Mary Kane of Bangor, be, and hereby is, repealed, to become effective July 1, 1941.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

Mary Kane of Bangor was granted a pension of \$15 per month under the provisions of chapter 77 of the resolves of 1939. She is now employed and no longer in need of public assistance.
