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**RESOLVE, to Repeal a Resolve Providing for a State Pension for  
Amelia Rittal.**

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**Resolves 1933, c. 182, repealed. Resolved:** That chapter 182 of the resolves of 1933, providing for a state pension for Amelia Rittal, be, and hereby is, repealed, to become effective July 1, 1941.

#### STATEMENT OF FACTS.

Amelia Rittal, of Dresden, was granted a pension of \$25 per month under the provisions of chapter 182 of the resolves of 1933. Mrs. Rittal has moved to Massachusetts and has no intention of returning to Maine.
