**RESOLVE, to Repeal a Resolve Providing for a State Pension for
Johanna T. Kelleher.**

Resolves, 1917, c. 117, repealed in part. Resolved: That that part of chapter 117 of the resolves of 1917 which provides for a state pension for Johanna T. Kelleher, be, and hereby is, repealed, to become effective July 1, 1941.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

Johanna T. Kelleher of Lewiston was granted a pension of \$12 per month under the provisions of chapter 117 of the resolves of 1917. She has been living in California for more than 10 years and evidently has no intention of returning to Maine.
