RESOLVE, to Repeal a Resolve Providing for a State Pension for Mary A. Moulton.

Resolves 1915, c. 304; repealed. Resolved: That chapter 304 of the resolves of 1915, providing for a state pension for Mary A. Moulton, be, and hereby is, repealed, to become effective July 1, 1941.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

Mary A. Moulton of Cushing was granted a state pension of \$8 per month under the provisions of chapter 304 of the resolves of 1915. She has been living outside of Maine, in California and in Florida, for more than 10 years and evidently has no intention of returning to the state.
