RESOLVE, to Repeal a Resolve Providing for a State Pension for Bessie King.

Resolves, 1925, c. 48; repealed. Resolved: That chapter 48 of the resolves of 1925, providing for a state pension for Bessie King, be, and hereby is, repealed, to become effective July 1, 1941.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

Bessie King of Belfast was granted a pension of \$12 per month under the provisions of chapter 48 of the resolves of 1925. She has lived outside of the state of Maine for more than 5 years and evidently has no intention of returning to the state.
