STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-ONE

AN ACT Relating to the Safety on Highways.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Riding on moving vehicles, regulated. No minor person, except when within the scope of his employment, shall ride on any part of a street car or motor vehicle not designed or intended for the conveyance of passengers. No minor person on a bicycle, roller skates, sled or similar device shall hold fast to or hitch onto any moving vehicle. No operator of any moving vehicle shall knowingly permit a violation of this act.
