RESOLVE, in Favor of the Town of Farmington.

Town of Farmington; reimbursed. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated, to be paid to the town of Farmington, the sum of \$143.03; it being the amount paid by said town for pauper supplies for Richard Crocker, state pauper; said sum to be taken from the general funds of the state.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

Pending the discovery of facts showing the status of Richard Crocker, the town of Farmington paid \$143.03 for supplies for this pauper. It has been now established that he was a state pauper.
