IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED

RESOLVE, to Repeal a Resolve Providing for a State Pension for Elizabeth McNaughton of Bangor.

Resolves, 1939, c. 77, repealed in part. Resolved: That that part of chapter 77 of the resolves of 1939 which provides for a state pension for Elizabeth McNaughton, of Bangor, be, and hereby is, repealed.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

Elizabeth McNaughton of Bangor is now a permanent inmate of the Home for Aged Women, at Bangor, and is no longer in need of the pension granted her under the provisions of chapter 77 of the resolves of 1939.
