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**RESOLVE, in Favor of Joseph L. Perry of Rumford.**

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**Joseph L. Perry; compensated. Resolved:** That there be, and hereby is, appropriated, the sum of \$3,000 be paid to Joseph L. Perry, of Rumford, as a settlement in full for all claims against the state for damages sustained by reason of the negligence of the state; said sum to be paid from the general funds of the state.

### STATEMENT OF FACTS

Armand T. Perry, the son of Joseph L. Perry, while on active duty with the National Guard of the state, died because of improper medical attendance. His father was not able to support the family of 6 children, and the funds supplied by Armand were the main support of the family.
