STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-ONE

AN ACT Relating to the Administration of State Institutions.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

- Sec. 1. P. L., 1939, c. 223, § 3, amended. Section 3 of chapter 223 of the public laws of 1939 is hereby repealed and the following enacted in place thereof:
- 'Sec. 3. Qualifications. The commissioner of institutional service shall be a person experienced in institutional administration, either as a superintendent, chief medical officer or business manager, or who has had other satisfactory experience in the direction of work of a comparable nature. Said commissioner shall have the power to appoint institutional heads and such other employees as shall be necessary for the proper performance of the duties of said department, said appointments to be with the approval of the governor and council.'
- Sec. 2. P. L., 1939, c. 223, § 4, amended. The second sentence in the second paragraph of section 4 of chapter 223 of the public laws of 1939 is hereby repealed and the following enacted in place thereof:

'The heads or superintendents of the several said institutions under the department shall report directly to the said commissioner.'
