**AN ACT Relating to the Theft of Motor Vehicles, Tires, Certain
Petroleum Products and Motor Vehicle Parts.**

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 131, amended. Chapter 131 of the revised statutes as amended is hereby further amended by adding at the end of section 1 thereof the following new section:

'Sec. 1-A. Larceny of motor vehicles, tires, certain petroleum products and motor vehicle parts. Whoever steals, takes and carries away, of the property of another, any motor vehicle, motor vehicle tire, motor vehicle tire tube, motor vehicle part or petroleum product used in the operation or lubrication of motor vehicles shall be punished when the value of such property exceeds \$100, by imprisonment for not less than 2 years nor more than 10 years; and when the value of such property does not exceed \$100, by imprisonment for not less than 3 months nor more than 11 months.'
