AN ACT Relating to Clerk Hire in Knox County.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 125, § 46. The 8th paragraph of section 46 of chapter 125 of the revised statutes, as amended, is hereby further amended to read as follows:

'Knox county: for clerks in the office of register of deeds, \$1040; for clerks in the office of register of probate, \$832; for clerks in the office of clerk of courts, ~~\$1040.~~ \$1300; for clerks in the office of sheriff during the 2nd world war, \$780.'
