STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-TWO

AN ACT Relating to the Open Season on Mink in Sagadahoc County.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 38, § 72, amended. The 6th paragraph of section 72 of chapter 38 of the revised statutes, as revised, is hereby amended to read as follows:

'The open season on mink shall be the month of November only, except that in the county of Sagadahoc the open season shall be for the month of December only.'
