AN ACT Relating to Gambling.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 136, § 11, amended. The 1st sentence of section 11 of chapter 136 of the revised statutes, as amended, is hereby further amended to read as follows:

'No person shall ~~travel from town to town, or from place to place, in any city, town, or plantation, on foot or by private or public conveyance, either by land or water, carrying, or having~~ have in possession, or ~~storing~~ **store**, any punch board, seal card, slot gambling machine, or other implements, apparatus, or materials of any form of gambling, and no person shall solicit, obtain, or offer to obtain orders for the sale or delivery of any punch board, seal card, slot gambling machine, or other implements, apparatus, or material of gambling.'
