STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-TWO

AN ACT Regulating Hours of Employment of Females.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 54, § 24, amended. Section 24 of chapter 54 of the revised statutes is hereby amended by adding at the end thereof the following:

'Females employed in any workshop, factory, manufacturing or mechanical establishment on a shift period of more than 6 hours shall be given not less than a 30-minute rest period on each shift.'
