RESOLVE, Relating to Digging Clams on Certain Islands in Hancock County.

Digging clams on certain islands, regulated. Resolved: That the commissioner of sea and shore fisheries be, and hereby is, directed to issue a rule and regulation to open certain clam flats to any clam digger in Hancock county; namely, Opechee island in the town of Swans Island and Cranberry Island and adjacent islands in their respective towns or any other flats that in said commissioner's judgment is for the best interest for the state and for defense.
