**RESOLVE, Authorizing the Forest Commissioner to Convey Certain Interest of the State in Land in Aroostook County to John Parent of Hamlin Plantation.**

---

**Forest commissioner authorized to convey certain land. Resolved:** That the forest commissioner be, and hereby is, authorized to convey to John Parent whatever interest the state has in lot 21 of the public lot in Hamlin Plantation (township G, Range 1, W. E. L. S.), Aroostook county, which was sold to John Parent of Hamlin Plantation by W. C. Hammond of Van Buren by a warranty deed dated July 17, 1868.
