STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-THREE

RESOLVE, Transferring Money from the Sinking Fund Reserve to the Penobscot Indian Trust Fund, the Passamaquoddy Indian Trust Fund, and the Indian Township Administration Fund.

Certain sums of money transferred from sinking fund reserve. Resolved: That the sum of \$7,550 be transferred from the sinking fund reserve of the state of Maine to the Penobscot Indian trust fund, this being the proceeds of sale of 3 of the Penobscot islands, October 11, 1835, and be it further

Resolved: That the sum of \$2,000 be transferred from the sinking fund reserve of the state of Maine to the Passamaquoddy Indian trust fund, this being the fair value of 15 islands in the St. Croix river lost by the Passamaquoddies to William Bingham under prior grant and the value having been determined in 1855, and be it further

Resolved: That the sum of \$2,486.17 be transferred from the sinking fund reserve of the state of Maine to the Passamaquoddy Indian trust fund, this being the amount paid in 1878 to satisfy a court decision in favor of Joseph Granger, the said amount having been charged out of said trust fund, and be it further

Resolved: That the sum of \$1,163.89 be transferred from the sinking fund reserve of the state of Maine to the Indian Township administration fund, this representing the total of balances which accrued in 1938-39 and 1939-40 after deductions of amounts expended on artesian well account and which were never transferred to the Indian fund.
