STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-THREE

AN ACT Providing Authority to Board of Trustees of the Maine Maritime Academy to Confer Degrees.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

P. & S. L., 1941, c. 37, amended. Section 6 of chapter 37 of the private and special laws of 1941, as enacted by chapter 97 of the private and special laws of 1941, is hereby amended by adding at the end thereof the following:

'Provided, further, that the board of trustees of the Maine Maritime Academy shall have the power to confer degrees of Bachelor of Marine Science (B.M.S.) and Bachelor of Marine Maintenance Engineering (B. M. M. E.) to graduates who have fulfilled requirements of 128 semester hours of collegiate work subsequent to graduation from a standard secondary school, but no further or other degree shall be conferred by the said Maritime Academy trustees without special authority from the legislature.'
