## STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-THREE

AN ACT Relating to Membership and Creditable Service in the Jointly-Contributory Retirement System for State Employees. Except Teachers.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. P. L., 1933, c. 1, § 227-C, sub-§ 6, amended. Subsection 6 of section 227-C of chapter 1 of the public laws of 1933, as enacted by chapter 328 of the public laws of 1941, is hereby amended by adding thereto the following sentence:

'The board of trustees may in its discretion, by a majority vote of the board, make the provisions of this section inapplicable in individual cases at such time as may be deemed appropriate.'

Sec. 2. P. L., 1933, c. 1, § 227-D, sub-§ 2, amended. Subsection 2 of section 227-D of chapter 1 of the public laws of 1933, as enacted by chapter 328 of the public laws of 1941, is hereby amended by adding at the end thereof the following sentence:

'Provided further, that any person formerly employed by the state at any time during the period of 3 years prior to July 1, 1942, and who is reemployed by the state at any time prior to July 1, 1943 shall, upon becoming a member, be allowed prior service credit.'
