STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-THREE

AN ACT Permitting Short Period Registration of Trucks.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 29, § 57, amended. Section 57 of chapter 29 of the revised statutes, as amended, is hereby further amended by adding at the end thereof a new paragraph to read as follows:

'Provided, further, that when a truck is already registered, the owner, by paying an additional fee may receive a short term permit allowing him to haul loads of larger tonnage for a limited period of less than I year. No such permit shall be issued for less than I month and no permit shall extend beyond the expiration of the regular license. The fee shall be a percentage of the difference between the owner's president registration fee and the annual fee for the desired tonnage and shall be computed according to the following table:

1-month	permit	 20%
2-month	permit	 30%
3-month	permit	 40%
4-month	permit	 50%
5-month	permit	 60%
6-month	permit	 70%
