AN ACT Providing for Destruction of Records.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Destruction of records. The old records of any state department which in the opinion of the head of such department are no longer of value to the state may be destroyed upon approval in writing of the attorney-general, state auditor, commissioner of finance and state historian but not otherwise, provided, however, that nothing herein shall be construed as amending or altering the provisions of section 121 of chapter 29 of the revised statutes as amended, which provisions are applicable only to the department of state.
