IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-THREE

AN ACT Relating to Bounty on Bears.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 38, § 79, amended. The 1st paragraph of section 79 of chapter 38 of the revised statutes, as revised, is hereby repealed and the following enacted in place thereof:

'A bounty of \$15 shall be paid for each and every bear killed in any town or unorganized place to the person killing the same by the treasurer of the town or by the treasurer of any adjoining town in which said bear was killed, and in the case of unorganized places by the treasurer of any adjoining town or of the nearest town where there are none adjoining. These bounties shall be paid by the treasurers of said towns.'
