STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED
FORTY-THREE

AN ACT Relating to Hunting and Trapping Bobcats.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. R. S., c. 38, § 72, sub-§ (c), amended. Subsection (c) of section 72 of chapter 38 of the revised statutes, as revised, is hereby amended to read as follows:

‘(c) It shall be lawful to hunt and trap bear **or bobcats** at any time, anywhere, in the state.’

Sec. 2. R. S. c. 38, § 72, sub-§ (i), amended. Subsection (i) of section 72 of chapter 38 of the revised statutes, as revised, is hereby amended to read as follows:

‘(i) Provided, further, that there shall be a closed season on trapping wild animals from May 15th to October 15th, of each year, both days inclusive, except as hereinbefore provided in paragraph (c) of this section, ~~provided, however, that it shall be lawful to trap bobcats in Aroostook county from October 15th to June 15th, both days inclusive.~~’
