STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-THREE

AN ACT to Extend the Charter of the Penobscot Lumbering Association for Fifteen Years.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

P. & S. L., 1854, c. 298, amended; charter extended 15 years. The charter of the Penobscot Lumbering Association as granted by chapter 298 of the private and special laws for the year 1854 and by all acts amendatory thereto is hereby renewed and extended for the further period of 15 years from and after the date of expiration of present charter and the authority of said Penobscot Lumbering Association to have and exercise its present rights, powers and privileges is also hereby renewed and extended for, and over said further period of 15 years.
