STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-THREE

AN ACT Providing for Badges Designating the Members of the Legislature.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Secretary of state to prepare suitable badges for members of the legislature. The secretary of state, immediately after the determination of the election of the senators and representatives to the legislature, shall prepare suitable badges for the said senators and representatives upon which shall appear the name of the member, his town, and county, his party, and his title; and shall mail said badges to the proper members within 2 weeks of the convening of the session of the legislature. The secretary of state may order as many additional badges as he may deem necessary, and arrange said badge so that inserts may be made carrying the name and town of the member.
