STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-THREE

AN ACT Relating to the Report of the State Tax Assessor.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 12, § 20, amended. Section 20 of chapter 12 of the revised statutes, as amended, is hereby repealed and the following enacted in place thereof:

'Sec. 20. To report annually to governor and council. The state tax assessor shall annually, before the 1st day of January, make a report to the governor and council of the proceedings of the bureau of taxation, and shall include therein tabular summaries derived from returns from local assessors, with summaries showing the taxes assessed against corporations, and such statistics and other information concerning revenue and taxation as may be deemed of public interest, and for the years in which the board of equalization shall have equalized the valuation of the state, its report shall include tabular statements of the state valuation by towns.'
