STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-THREE

AN ACT Relating to Assessment of Taxes on Lands in Places Not Incorporated.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 13, § 37, amended. Section 37 of chapter 13 of the revised statutes is hereby amended to read as follows:

'Sec. 37. Lands in places not incorporated may be taxed by the state. Lands not exempt, and not liable to be assessed in any town, may be taxed by the legislature for a just proportion of all state, county and forestry district taxes as herein provided for ordering the state, county and forestry district taxes upon property liable to be assessed in towns. The board of equalization shall make lists thereof, with as many divisions as will secure equitable taxation, conforming as near as convenient to known divisions and separate ownership., and report the same to each successive legislature.'
