STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-THREE

AN ACT Relating to Fees of Town Clerks for Issuance of Hunting Licenses.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 38, § 41, sub-§ 4, amended. The 2nd paragraph of subsection 4 of section 41 of chapter 38 of the revised statutes, as revised, is hereby amended to read as follows:

'Each agent shall on the 1st of each month forward to the commissioner a report containing a list of the persons to whom he has issued licenses since his last report, the class of each license and the total amount of the funds by him collected and shall at the same time forward to the commissioner the funds by him collected less the amount of 15c, as above provided for each license, except, however, if less than 10 licenses have been sold in a single month, the cost of money order and postage to send such money to the commissioner shall be subtracted from the amount the agent has collected and the balance shall be sent forward to the commissioner as above provided for each license, which funds shall be deposited in the state treasury by said commissioner.'
