IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-THREE

AN ACT Relating to Bonds of Probation Officers.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 147, § 10, amended. Section 10 of chapter 147 of the revised statutes, as amended, is hereby further amended by adding at the end thereof a new paragraph to read as follows:

'The county commissioners shall, whenever necessary, request the probation officer to give corporate surety bond to the county in such sum as the county commissioners shall approve, conditioned that he shall, during his term of office, faithfully perform all the duties of his office.'
